## How to Qualify for this Service?

- Anyone who has below to moderate income level can apply;
- All applicants must provide proof of identity (a picture ID) and residency;
- Applicant does not have to provide proof of income only the number of family members in the household. Personal information will not be shared with any other agencies.

## History

We have operated the food pantry ministry for eight years. When we started the pantry ministry, we were only able to serve the families once a month. Praise God, we typically serve 15 families on a regular basis twice a month; and 5 to 7 families on an emergency basis each month. We strive to meet the food needs of the applicants in a timely and professional fashion.

## Pick-Up Schedule

Pick-up dates are twice a month the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month; boxes include nutritional food for a well balanced meal and literature for a happy well balanced life. Pick-up hours: 3:30 p.m. thru 6:00 p.m.
